Impossible Cauliflower Quiche

2 c fresh or 1 9oz bag (frozen) cauliflower (you can use other vegetables instead i.e.: Broccoli or broccoli/cauliflower mix etc.)

1/3 c chopped onion (I use 1 onion)

1/2 c chopped green pepper (I use 1 pepper)

1 c shredded Colby cheese (4oz pkg) (sharp cheese is good too or any favorite shredded cheese)

1 c milk

1/2 c bisquick

3 eggs

Dash of pepper

Cook vegetables in boiling water for about 10 min. or until just tender, drain well. Place in greased 9 inch pie pan. Sprinkle onion, green pepper and cheese on top.

Put remaining ingredients in blender for 15 seconds. Pour over veggies and bake at 375 for 20-25 minutes or until knife comes out clean and top is golden brown. Let stand 5 minutes; serve with a salad.
